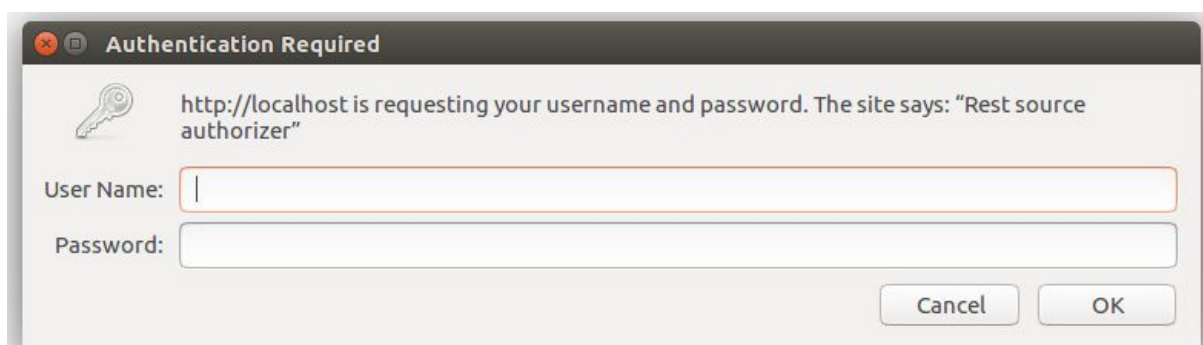
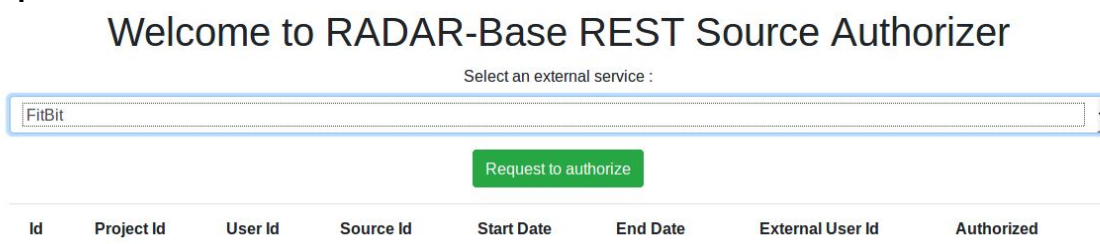


Fitbit user registration for RADAR-base

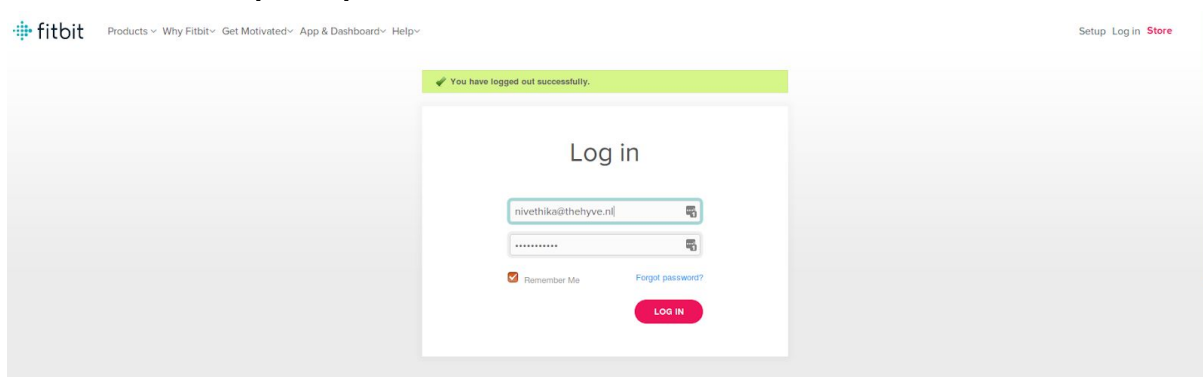
1. Go to ``<your-platform-url>/rest-sources/authorizer/`` in your browser. You will be prompt to authenticate yourself. Please **enter the credentials given by the system administrator** for “Rest source authorizer”.



2. Once you are authenticated, you will see the homepage of the application. Select “**FitBit**” from the drop-down under “Select and external service” and click on “**Request to authorize**”.



3. You will be redirected to login to Fitbit page. Please **login** using the **Fitbit account credentials of the participant**.



4. Once successfully logged in the Fitbit user will be requested to authorize radar-base application to collect listed data from their Fitbit account. Please click on “**Allow all**” then “**Allow**”.

5. The last step is to add metadata of this radar-base user from ManagementPortal, available at `<your-platform-url>/managementportal/`. (Prerequisite for this step is the creation of a 'Project' for your study and a 'Subject' for this participant in ManagementPortal (MP). See Appendix I).
 - a. Fill in the *Project-id* from MP as **Project id** and *Subject-id* from MP as **User-id**.
 - b. Use the datepicker to select the **Start date and End date** to specify from which date to which date you want to collect data from this participant.
 - c. Finally click on "**Submit**" button.
